




Registration for Summer Camp 2023 is now open! Camp brochures are here!

<u>Trinity United Methodist Church Library Notes</u> June 2023

We have 2 new classic books.

CS Lewis's **Mere Christianity** is his explanation of the Christian theology. It was adapted from a British Broadcast Company series of radio talks made during World War II originally as 3 books: **Broadcast Talks** (1942), **Christian Behavior** (1943), and **Beyond Personality** (1944). Mr. Lewis provides an argument for the existence of God (without using the Bible), a defense of Christian Theology, Christian ethics, and the Christian Conception of God. It is "a must" for any Christian or non-Christian to read.

Basic Christianity by John Stott. John Stott was an English pastor and considered by many to be the father of modern evangelism. In the most popular of his 50 books, he explains the message of Christianity in order to convince his readers of its truth and importance. This is "another must" for believers as well as those who are seeking Christ as their Lord and Savior.

5. Display them on your fridge, mirror, or in your car for others to see.




