From Pastor Jason's Desk

In the church calendar, "Ordinary Time" may sound uneventful compared to the dramatic seasons of Advent, Christmas, Lent, or Easter. But don't let the name fool you—this season is anything but boring. The word "ordinary" comes from "ordinal," meaning "counted time," and it refers to the weeks outside the major celebrations when we walk with Jesus through His everyday ministry.

Ordinary Time invites us to grow in steady faithfulness. It reminds us that most of life isn't lived on mountaintops or valleys but in the rhythm of daily devotion, small acts of obedience, and quiet faithfulness. This is where deep spiritual growth often happens—not through dramatic moments, but through consistent time in God's Word, prayer, and community.

During this season, we learn to see God in the ordinary. The meals, conversations, work, and rest can be sacred when done with Him. So, rather than seeing Ordinary Time as a pause between more exciting seasons, let's see it as a time to cultivate deep roots and lasting fruit. We must remember that we are about to celebrate Pentecost, the birth of the Christian church. That is always a reason to celebrate.

In these "ordinary" days, may we become extraordinary followers of Christ, growing steadily in grace, love, and faith.




There are no minute from the Administrative Council/Finance Committees as they didn't meet in April.
