TUMC ADMINISTRATIVE COUNCIL/FINANCE MINUTES

The Trinity United Methodist Church Administrative Council/Finance meeting was held on Thursday, June 24, 2021, 6:30 p.m., in the CMC. Members present: Pastor Peggy Hanson, Gary Linn, Sue Holloway, Cindy McNeill, Bob McNeill, Pete Fuller, and Lynn Larsen.

Gary Linn called the meeting to order and opened the meeting with a devotion and prayer.

Pete Fuller requested the Annual Conference Report be moved to the first item on the agenda.

Pete Fuller reviewed with the Admin Council the two resolutions that came out of Annual Conference. The two resolutions are 1.2 Resolution, "A Vision for a More Just Church" and 1.3 Resolution, "Preparing for Denominational Separation." He stated these two resolutions are of hope, not binding and with no legal effect. They each have different viewpoints and opinions and are laid out in the two different plans. Discussion on these two resolutions was held with many questions coming from the council members. Pastor Peggy attended the Annual Conference "in person" in Sioux Falls and Gary Linn went to Rapid City to attend the Annual Conference via Zoom.

Sue Holloway moved/ Cindy McNeill seconded to **approve the May 20, 2021 minutes** as printed. **Motion carried.**

Sue Holloway, Finance Chair, reviewed the Financial Reports with the Admin Council. Cindy McNeill moved/ Bob McNeill seconded to **approve the May 2021 Financial Reports. Motion carried.** Pastor Peggy gave an update on the rebate the church will be receiving from the Dakotas Conference Board of Pensions. The Dakotas Conference will be distributing rebates to churches and pastors throughout the Dakotas Conference. She reported the amount our church will be receiving is \$38,985.34. The council is considering paying off our debts and then take our time to figure out what we may want to do with the rest of the money.

Bob McNeill, Trustees Chair, reported the security system project is waiting for more parts to arrive before we can complete this project. Bug spray has been put the lawns at the church and parsonage. Work Day was held on the 19th and most of the items on the list of things to do were accomplished. The dishwasher at the CMC has been repaired. He also noted the pictures of the four churches Shelly Drago drew are now back on the wall behind the sanctuary.

Pastor Peggy noted she did the memorial service for Bob Harvey today. This coming Saturday she will be officiating the wedding for Clacy Percy and LeeRoy Leal. The "Missional Mondays" held on Mondays that the youth are doing throughout the summer in the communities of Lead- Deadwood and surrounding areas have been successful. They have donated their time at Storm Mountain and baked cookies giving them to both police departments, hospital workers, employees at Lynn's and Golden Ridge residents. The Hansons plan to take vacation from June 30 to July 3. The July 4th celebration events in Lead include a community church service in the City Park at 10 a.m. Prior to the church service at the Lead Park there will be a coffee fellowship at the CMC at 9:00 a.m. She will be attending a couple of church camps in July at Storm Mountain. Vacation Bible Study will be held July 18 through 22. Sunday School will begin September with a kick-off event.

Sue Holloway reported on the Meals on Wheels program. The garage sale she had during the Lead-Deadwood garage sale week-end brought in \$220. The Trinity United Methodist Women will be holding their first meeting on August 26 with a picnic at the Lead City Park.

Cindy McNeill, Staff Pastor Parish Chair, reported the committee has completed the 2021 Clergy/Church Annual Assessment and sent to the Dakotas Conference.

Sue Holloway, Biker Breakfast Chair, reported a couple of people have signed up to help with Biker Breakfast. She will have sign-up sheets at the church and CMC starting July 11th.

The next Finance/ Administrative Council meeting will be held on Thursday, July 15, 2021, 6:30 p.m. in the CMC. Pastor Peggy closed the meeting with prayer.

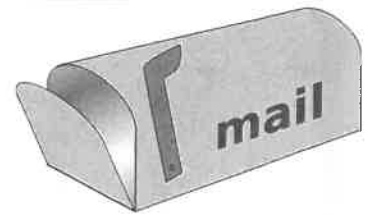

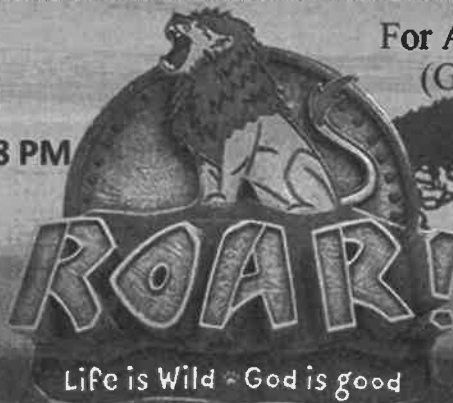
