## TUMC ADMINISTRATIVE COUNCIL/FINANCE MINUTES

The Trinity United Methodist Church Administrative Council/Finance meeting was held on Thursday, May 20, 2021, 6:30 p.m., in the CMC. Members present: Pastor Peggy Hanson, Gary Linn, Sue Holloway, Syd DeVries, Shelli DeVries, Cindy McNeill, Bob McNeill, Brian Hanson, Jacque Fuller, and Lynn Larsen.

Gary Linn called the meeting to order and opened the meeting with a devotion and prayer.

Cindy McNeill moved/ Syd DeVries seconded to **approve the April 22, 2021 minutes** as printed. **Motion carried.**

Sue Holloway, Finance Chair, reviewed the Financial Reports with the Admin Council. Syd DeVries moved/Cindy McNeill seconded to **approve the April 2021 Financial Reports.** **Motion carried.**

Pastor Peggy reported she has received word from the Dakotas Conference Board of Pensions they will be distributing rebates to churches and pastors throughout the Dakotas. In the next few weeks she will be receiving more details with dollar amounts each church will be receiving.

Bob McNeill, Trustees Chair, reported they met an hour prior to the Admin Council meeting. The Wesley Room is done for the most part with only a few minor items that need to be completed. The security system project is ongoing. Bug spray will be put on the lawns at the church and parsonage. Work Day will be held on Saturday, June 19, 2021, from 8:30-2:00. A list of items that need to be done at the church will be in the June newsletter. It will greatly be appreciated for those who can volunteer to help with the various projects on the list.

Pastor Peggy noted she will be doing the summer worship services at Rochford on June 20 and August 22. The youth group has ended their weekly meetings and will resume in the fall. This summer they will be doing "Missional Mondays" on Mondays throughout the summer in the communities of Lead and Deadwood. Some of the services the youth will be volunteering for include a deep clean at the Lord's Cupboard, jobs at the Twin City Animal Shelter, a baking day making cookies to deliver to the hospital workers and police officers. One of the Mondays they will go to Storm Mountain to help with anything that needs to be done. Annual Conference will be held on June 11. Pastor Peggy plans to leave for Sioux Falls on June 10. This conference will be hybrid. The Grief Sharing group started on May 18 with three in attendance. She has one wedding and two funerals in June. The Hansons plan to take vacation from June 30 to July 3.

Shelli DeVries, Christian Ed Chair, reported the Bible study on Thursday mornings on the Book of Philippians was finished this past week. Thirteen women did the study. This Bible study group will resume in the fall. Syd DeVries is doing a Bible study for men on Saturday mornings at 7:30 a.m. at the CMC. He is hoping to also do this study via Zoom. Sunday School will start back up on September 12 with a kick-off event. Vacation Bible study has been moved to the week of July 18 through 22. Volunteers are needed to play games. The jungle theme for VBS this year is, "Roar"—Life is Wild, God is Good."

Sue Holloway is still needing volunteers for Meal on Wheels. Since COVID restrictions have been lifted, the Trinity United Methodist Women were finally able to meet this May. They will have their annual picnic on August 26. Sue noted so far a few people have volunteered to help with Biker Breakfast.

Pastor Peggy informed the Council since July 4<sup>th</sup> is on a Sunday this year plans are in the works to have a church community service in the Lead City Park at 10 a.m. Discussion was held on this church service and if our church would want to participate in this service at the park. Sue Holloway moved/Cindy McNeill seconded to **participate in the July 4<sup>th</sup> church service in the Lead City Park and our church will not have an official service on Sunday, July 4<sup>th</sup>.** **Motion carried.**

The next Finance/ Administrative Council meeting will be held on Thursday, June 17, 2021, 6:30 p.m. in the CMC. Pastor Peggy closed the meeting with prayer.

We welcome all who want to be part of an organization that is more than potlucks and vacuum cleaners! Please come!


