David Vardiman moved that the May 17<sup>th</sup> minutes be approved as printed. Second John Hauge. Carried

Finance:

Lisa Koppman Vice President of Finance at UBS gave an overview of the investments that the Church has with them. We have two separate accounts. One for Capital Improvement and the other for Operating Cash. She outlined several ways that our cash flow could be increased.

There were many questions and suggestions for these investments. If you wish to know more about them, there are reports available or you may check with anyone on the finance committee.

Finance New Business: David Vardiman

Motion by John Hauge we accept the following motions. Cameon Wefso second. Carried

1. Transfer \$1516.45 of undesignated funds into the Snow Removal Fund to offset the existing -\$516 .45 balance with a \$1000 balance for next winter
2. Transfer the remaining \$2.43 of the Post Prom Fund into the Health Fund(Health Kits) and eliminate the Post Prom Fund.
3. Transfer the remaining \$45.51 of the donated Piano Fund into the Projection System Fund and eliminated the Piano Fund.
4. Transfer \$2,000 from the Memorial Funds into the Projection System Fund.

The Change for a Change brought in \$200 for Clothe-A-Kid. Sue Holloway sent information that last year our Church raised \$800-\$1000. Sharon Narem moved that we give \$500 of Biker Breakfast money to the Clothe-A-Kid project. Vickie Hauge Second. Carried.

Vickie Hauge moved to accept the June Financial Reports. Cameon Wefso Second Carried.

Debbie Vardiman moved that TUMC reduce the payment we make to conference to 10% rather than 16%. Vickie Hauge second. After discussion Debbie amended the motion to table this request until the next meeting. Vickie seconded the amended motion. Carried

Gary Linn conducted the Administrative meeting

Trustees: Cameon J-Wefso reported that workday will be June 23<sup>rd</sup> beginning at 9 am. There are 35 jobs on the list. Some small some large. **The** sprinkler system is finished at a total cost of \$4986. Thank you to all the members who did manual labor to help the installing crew. **The** kitchen flooring is in at a total cost of \$10, 890. The panels are removable if one gets damaged.

Staff Pastor Parish: Royal Brooking reported that Pastor Peggy Hanson's evaluation was completed.

Trinity UMW: Vickie Hauge reported that Wed. June 20<sup>th</sup> the fundraiser for Stacy Helmin was held. Good attendance and funds raised. The picnic for UMW will be in August.

Worship: Debbie Vardiman created an usher duty list.

Youth: Pastor Peggy and three young people are in Racine WI for a Mission Trip

## TUMC June 2018 Finance Committee Newsletter

All June 2018 church expenses are forecast to be paid in full by the end of the month with no anticipated outstanding liabilities remaining. The projected end-of-month (June) available undesignated cash balance is forecast in the amount of **\$10,275**.

In addition to the forecast amount above, the church has received notice of a pending rebate on our conference Pension & Health Flex expenses in the amount of \$6,778.27. The projected cash balance stated above will increase by this amount, if this check is received and deposited prior to the end of the June.

A generous donation of \$1,500 was also received during the month from the Kiewit/Alberici Joint Venture management team for utilization of the CMC during the Sanford Underground Research Facility LBNF project subcontractor pre-bid site visits.

The Administrative Council approved the following motions.

- 1.) Transfer \$1,516.45 of undesignated funds into the Snow Removal Fund to offset the existing -\$516.45 balance with a \$1,000 balance for next winter.
- 2.) Transfer the remaining \$45.51 of the donated Piano Fund into the Projection System Fund and eliminate the Piano Fund.
- 3.) Transfer the remaining \$2.43 of the Post Prom Fund into the Health Fund (Health Kits) and eliminate the Post Prom Fund.
- 4.) Transfer \$2,000 from the Memorial funds into the Projection System Fund.
- 5.) A motion to fund Clothe-A-Kid with a \$500 contribution from Biker Breakfast.
